

1992 Benetton B192

As driven by Martin Brundle at the 1992 Canadian Grand Prix

This one is a tribute to a driver who I feel is very underrated and rarely had a car worthy of his talent. This is a Tamiya kit that I don't think has ever been reissued. I found this one recently in Japan. The decals were too old and wouldn't release from the paper regardless of what I tried.

Painting the body was tricky, the green is Testors enamel and the Yellow is Tamiya acrylic. Lots of bleeding of the enamel !

This is what I did:

- 1) Belkits Carbon Fibre decals; 30 pieces added
- 2) Studio 27 Photo Etch set; 18 pcs. used, including the replacement of 2 kit parts
- 3) Indycals main livery & sponsor decals
- 4) Shunko decals
- 5) Added 6 radiator hoses from parts box
- 6) Added Detail Master ignition lines
- 7) HGW Seat Belt kit, first removed molded in belts
- 8) Model Factory Hiro Heat Shields added
- 9) Virage Tire Decals
- 10) Airbox; added the underside of the intake using sheet plastic
